- In our institution Army and Naval NCC units are running for more than last 60 years. At present three units are running namely 1 MP Signal Coy. NCC with cadets strength 213 Cadets (173 boys and 40 girls cadet).
- In Jabalpur Division our institution has maximum number of cadets, which is more than 300.
