

Expert for the talk was Dr Aniruddha Majumdar, Scientist and divisional incharge, Animal Ecological division, State forest research institute, Jabalpur. Most important part about Dr Majumdar was that he was one of the State board members who has surveyed about ecology favourable to Cheetah and submitted their report for Kuno National Park dist Shivpur. On the recommendation of their report Central government decided to release Cheetah in Kuno national park of M.P.

Expert Lecture Abstract:

Till now Madhya Pradesh was known as Tiger State, Leopard State, Gharial State and Vulture State, now after the arrival of Cheetahs in Kuno National Park, it will also be known as Cheetah State. This information was given by Dr. Anirudh Majumdar, Scientist SFRI, Jabalpur on the occasion of the inauguration of the Zoological Council on 20.09.2022 organized at the Government Science College on 20.09.2022.

He gave detailed information about differences in body structure, claw marks, paintings, behavior of animals coming in the categories of cheetah, tiger, leopard and jaguar big cats.

Describing the specialty of cheetah, He told that cheetah is the fastest running animal and skilled hunter of the forest!

Explaining the reason behind bringing cheetah to Kuno National Park, Dr. Majumdar told that the climate of Kuno grassland is favorable for cheetahs. In future, this scheme will strengthen the local ecology and economic aspect. According to you there is a plan to bring a total of 20 leopards in Kuno! At the end of the speech expert answered the questions asked by the students
